CANOPY TENT WEIGHT GUIDELINES

Most accidents at events involve tents. It is your responsibility to minimize the risk. Rules to remember:

- Your tent should be fully secured before setting up anything else. Staff will enforce this during set up.
- Be sure that your method of securing your tent to the ground does not create an additional hazard.
 - Use appropriate tent weights and straps.

WEIGHTS

Weather can be unpredictable, and strong winds can turn tents into flying weapons. All event participants using a tent must have their own weights with a minimum of 40 pounds per tent leg. Gallon water jugs and bricks or blocks are not safe. A gallon of water weighs only 8 pounds and a single brick is worthless, weighing in at 3 pounds. PVC pipe filled with concrete tent weight sandbags, or canopy weight discs/plates are safe ways to weigh down your tents.

Setup and breakdown periods are when canopies consistently prove to be most vulnerable to wind. You must be sure to <u>completely secure your tent as soon as you set it up</u>. Take down your canopy as soon as you remove your weights after the event.

Do not let yourself be interrupted by anything during this process, as a half-secured canopy is as dangerous, if not more dangerous than an unsecured canopy.

APPROVED WEIGHTS

- PVC pipe filled with concrete (40-50lbs per leg)
 - Can <u>DIY</u> using PVC and quickcrete
- EZ-Up sandbags or similar
 - Can purchase unfilled through Amazon
- Canopy discs/plates (40lbs per leg)
 - o Can buy at Home Depot, Ace Hardware, etc.

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED

- Gallon jugs, or larger jugs without handles molded into the body (handles can snap)
- Dumbbells (can't secure correctly to tent)
- Weightlifting plates (used for bodybuilding cannot be secured adequately)
- Bricks (can't secure correctly AND not heavy enough)
- Concrete blocks/Cinder blocks (can't secure correctly AND create a tripping hazard
- Merchandising racks
- Coolers, storage or other bins
- Stakes in the ground
